Important Changes to Child Support Payments

The Michigan State Disbursement Unit (MISDU) is moving to a new service platform starting November 25, 2020.

Because of this, there will be changes for parties who get child support and parties who pay child support.

If you get child support:

- If you get your support payments on a U.S. Bank ReliaCard, you will get a new Way2Go Prepaid Mastercard in early November.
 - Way2Go Prepaid Mastercard is a chip-enabled debit card issued by Comerica Bank.
 - With the new Way2Go Card, there is a new website www.GoProgram.com and a mobile app for downloading to your Apple or Android device.
 - o Payments will be put on your U.S. Bank ReliaCard until November 29, 2020.
 - Balances will **not** transfer to your Way2Go Card. You should spend all money on your U.S. Bank ReliaCard
 - o Payments on the Way2Go Card will begin on November 30, 2020. You must activate your new Way2Go Card by November 29, 2020 to prevent any delays in receiving your payments.
- If get your support payments direct deposited into your personal bank account, nothing will change for you.
- If you do not want to receive child support payments on a debit card, you may request direct deposit into
 your bank account by going to www.misdu.com, click "Receiving Payment" on the left, and complete a
 direct deposit form.

If you pay child support:

- If you are signed up to make online payments, you will need to sign up to make online payments through ExpertPay on www.misdu.com by November 24, 2020. If you are currently signed up, it will not automatically transfer to the new system.
- ExpertPay on www.misdu.com allows employers and payers to set up and make recurring payments via ACH (debit to your bank account) and all credit/debit card payments.
- Please go to www.misdu.com/secure/Transition.aspx for information on how to register, stop existing recurring payments, and other transition related updates.
- Payers who are not signed up may still make one-time only payments at www.misdu.com.
- If your employer is currently sending in your payments, you do not need to do anything.
- If you make payments at a retailer using PayNearMe or Moneygram, you will not need to re-register for these services.
