Subject: S.T.A.N.D. Wayne County Juvenile Drug Court

The Third Circuit Court's Supervised Treatment for Alcohol and Narcotic Dependency (S.T.A.N.D.) aims to eliminate juvenile's substance use and abuse and delinquent behavior. Currently the program has 40 participants and 12 are slated to graduate. These graduates have been acknowledged for their progress throughout the program for continued abstinence and improved academic achievement with applause, high fives, movie passes, and gift cards. On September 2, 2015, they will be honored with Pomp and Circumstances at a ceremony to be held in the Friends' Auditorium, Detroit Public Library Main Branch on Woodward in Detroit.

Justice David F. Viviano of the Michigan Supreme Court will deliver remarks and join the Third Circuit Court Chief Judge Robert J. Colombo, Jr., Presiding Judge Virgil C. Smith, and Judge Karen Braxton congratulating the 2015 September S.T.A.N.D. graduates. Many Commissioners and state legislators have also confirmed that they will be in attendance to acknowledge the graduates and the success of the S.T.A.N.D. program.
