Program Highlights

- The Friend of the Court has continued its efforts to help payers overcome barriers to paying their obligated child support through the POWER Court. POWER stands for Providing Opportunities for Work, Education, and Respect. The assigned referee and staff help participants secure educational, training, and employment resources. In January 2013, there were 152 active cases on this docket.
- Over 450 people received free legal assistant at the Salvation Army's William Booth Legal Service Clinic held monthly at the Court.
- The Friend of the Court continues its community public education efforts working with the Veteran population, the Detroit Public Library, Wayne County Head Start, and other community agencies.
- The Friend of the Court volunteered to participate in a statewide pilot project offering relief on state owed arrearages for hardship. The pilot begins in 2013.
