REQUEST FOR PARENTING TIME/CUSTODY ENFORCEMENT

Please read this instruction sheet first.

You claim that the other parent has violated your court order regarding parenting time and/or custody. A "REQUEST FOR PARENTING TIME/CUSTODY ORDER ENFORCEMENT" is attached. Your situation *must* meet these four requirements:

- YES, I have a Wayne County domestic relations case for my child(ren).
- YES, I have a court order for custody and a parenting time schedule in my case.
- **YES**, the other parent has violated the court ordered parenting time or has violated the custody provisions of the Order.
- YES, the violation happened less than 56 days ago. If the denial of parenting time took place more than 56 days before the filing of this Enforcement Request, your Request will not be reviewed.

*At a minimum, your Request for Enforcement must state the date(s) you were denied parenting time/custody, the custody or parenting time that is allowed in the current Court Order, and describe what happened that makes you believe that you have been denied the custody or parenting time that is allowed in your Court Order.

If your situation meets all the requirements above and you follow the instructions below, the Friend of the Court will take steps to enforce your Order.

This Enforcement Request must be filed at the Wayne County Clerk's Office.

THIS PACKET IS ONLY FOR ENFORCEMENT OF EXISTING PARENTING TIME/CUSTODY ORDERS.

IF YOU THINK THE PARENTING TIME OR CUSTODY ORDER SHOULD BE CHANGED, YOU MUST FILE A MOTION TO MODIFY PARENTING TIME (FD/FOC 4031) OR MOTION TO CHANGE CUSTODY (FD/FOC 4018). Modification forms are available on our website at www.3rdcc.org and clicking on the Forms tab.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Fill out Praecipe and Request for Parenting Time/Custody Enforcement. USE BLACK OR BLUE INK ONLY.
- 2. Write your Case Number in the upper right corner of every page.
- 3. Attach a copy of your most recent parenting time/custody Order. If you do not attach a copy of your most recent Order, your enforcement request may take longer to process.
- 4. Make 3 sets of copies.
- 5. Always keep a copy of every paper you file with the Court and bring your copies with you to the hearing.
- 6. Once you file your Request for Parenting Time/Custody Enforcement, your request will be scheduled for hearing before the referee. Prior to the hearing, your motion may be reviewed and one of the following actions occur:
 - a. A decision will be made that you do not have a parenting time schedule in your Order or custody in place that the Court can enforce. If such a decision is made, you will receive a letter notifying you that you must file a Motion to Modify Parenting Time or Custody.
 - b. Your case may be referred to the Dispute Resolution Unit/Family Assessment Mediation and Education Unit of the Court for mediation with a qualified mediator. This process allows the parties to try to resolve this matter.
 - c. Make-up parenting time may be ordered in accordance with the current parenting time Order.

IF YOU ARE FILING ONLINE (RECOMMENDED):

- The electronic filing system can be found at www.3rdcc.org/agency-resources. Click on Outside Agency Web Access under Applications Access to set up an account and to access the Domestic Case Filings System. Review User Guide for Domestic Case Electronic Filers under How to Tutorials for detailed instructions on how to access the system.
- 2. Note: this request must be filed as a pleading (not a motion).
- 3. You will receive an email once your Motion has been accepted for filing.
- 4. Once you receive the email that your Motion has been accepted, you must submit a Friend of the Court ePraecipe at https://www.3rdcc.org/efiling/epraecipe to schedule your motion for hearing before the referee assigned to your case.

5. Once you have submitted the ePraecipe, you will receive a completed copy back with your hearing date on it. Please note that the final hearing date may be different from what was requested on the ePraecipe, due to Court availability.

IF YOU ARE FILING IN PERSON:

- 1. Take your original and three copies of your "Request for Parenting Time/Custody Enforcement" to the Wayne County Clerk in Room 201 (CAYMC 2nd Floor).
- 2. Put case labels (stickers) in the upper right corner of original documents and copies. Case labels are free and available in **Room 201**.
- 3. Give the Clerk your original "Request for Parenting Time/Custody Enforcement". There is no filing fee.
- 4. The Clerk will keep the original forms.
- 5. Take a copy of your "Request for Parenting Time/Custody Enforcement" to the FOC Scheduling Office in Room 900A (CAYMC 9TH floor).
- 6. At the window of **Room 900A**, an FOC representative will take all of your paperwork and give you a hearing date.
- 7. Go to your hearing with all documents that prove the request in your motion. If you do not show up, or if you show up late, your motion will be dismissed.

IF YOU ARE FILING BY MAIL:

- Mail your original forms and 3 sets of copies to: <u>Wayne County Clerk, Room 201, Coleman A. Young Municipal Center, Two Woodward Ave., Detroit, MI 48226</u>. There is no filing fee.
- 2. Keep copies of everything you mail to the Court.
- 3. Include a Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope and a letter asking the County Clerk to mail you a receipt and a copy of your motion stamped "filed."

- YOU WANT TO CHANGE THE CURRENT PARENTING TIME ORDER OR CUSTODY ORDER

YOUR MOTION/ENFORCEMENT REQUEST WILL BE REVIEWED BY THE FRIEND OF THE COURT. YOU WILL RECEIVE FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS BY MAIL INCLUDING THE DATE OF ANY SCHEDULED MEDIATION OR YOUR SCHEDULED HEARING DATE.
