CASES FILED BY THE CITY OF DETROIT INVOLVING THE COMMON

LEGAL ISSUE OF WHETHER PROPERTY OWNERS CAN BE HELD

PERSONALLY LIABLE FOR DELINQUENT PROPERTY TAXES

Pursuant to Administrative Order 1989-3 (Assignment of Actions: Related Actions), all cases involving the issue of whether a property owner can be held liable for the payment of delinquent property taxes in civil housing (CH) actions filed by the City of Detroit shall be reassigned and assigned to the Chief Judge. The City of Detroit shall affix the following language to the face of the initial complaint in each of these actions upon filing and the County Clerk shall cause the case to be assigned to the Chief Judge: "Tax Liability Issue: assign to Chief Judge."

It is further directed that the City of Detroit shall file a motion for summary disposition in each case no later than 28 days from the filing of a defendant's answer. In addition, plaintiff, City of Detroit, is directed to serve a copy of this docket directive on each defendant along with the summons and complaint.
