STATE OF MICHIGAN THIRD JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

SUBJECT: "AP" Case Types – Appeals filed by Prisoners from Decisions of the Michigan Parole Board, pursuant to MCR 7.104(D)

This Docket Directive applies to all appeals filed by prisoners challenging the decision of the Michigan Parole Board to deny parole (case types = AP).

The County Clerk should no longer accept or initiate AP case types, wherein a prisoner is appealing the denial of parole, pursuant to the amended Michigan Court Rule 7.104(D) which eliminated the references to an appeal of parole decisions by a prisoner. The County Clerk shall continue to accept or initiate AP case types wherein a prisoner is appealing revocation of parole.

A prisoner's right to appeal denials of parole made by the Michigan Parole Board was eliminated by the Legislature in 1999 PA 191, amending MCL 791.234; MSA 28.2304.

This Docket Directive is necessary for the purposes of administrative and judicial efficiency and it revokes Docket Directive 2001-02.
