**SUBJECT: Felony Auto Theft Cases**


**EFFECTIVE: April 2, 2001**

Pursuant to the provisions of MCR 8.111(B) assignment of cases:

This directive applies to all Felony Auto Theft Cases which include MCL 750.535A2 (Operating Chop Shop); MCL 750.535 et. seq. (Receiving and Concealing Stolen Property); MCL 750.413 (UDAA); MCL 750.45111 (Insurance Fraud); MCL 750.4152 (Altering VIN); MCL 257.254 (Possession of Stolen Motor Vehicle W/Intent to Pass Title) and MCL 257.254 (False Statement in Application of Title).

All cases involving an automobile theft charged under the above-enumerated codes will be assigned to Judge Richard P. Hathaway.

The criminal docket (cases pending and post judgments) of Judge Richard P. Hathaway will be reassigned to Judge Michael M. Hathaway.
