**SUBJECT: PROCEEDINGS REGARDING ABANDONED HOUSING AND
NUISANCE ABATEMENT PROJECT**

This directive is issued pursuant to MCR 8.111 (B).

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Effective, September 30, 2005, all civil proceedings filed in the Third Judicial Circuit related to or arising out of the Abandoned Housing and Nuisance Abatement Project initiated by the City of Inkster will be assigned to the docket of Judge Michael F. Sapala using the judicial docket code of **CFCON**. The City of Inkster shall clearly identify all actions subject to this Docket Directive at case initiation.

This docket directive is necessary for purposes of administrative efficiency, judicial economy and to avoid for potential conflicting decisions on the same issue by judges of the same court.

The Wayne County Clerk and Third Circuit Court Docket Management are directed to take the appropriate action to accomplish the assignment of these cases.

This Docket Directive rescinds Docket Directive 2002-08.
