STATE OF MICHIGAN THIRD JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

SUBJECT: Drug Treatment Program

This directive is issued pursuant to MCR 8.110 and MCR 8.111(B) and is necessary to ensure the efficient assignment of cases eligible for the Drug Treatment Program pursuant to the Court's Criminal Division Case Assignment Local Administrative Order.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

A defendant is eligible for the drug treatment program if he or she is assessed as an identifiable drug user, and is charged under the Controlled Substances Act or with one of the following related violations:

Possession with intent to deliver under 50 grams [MCL 333.7401(2)(A)(4)], possession under 50 grams [MCL 333.7403(2)(A)(4)], possession under 25 grams [MCL 333.7403(2)(A)(5)], manufacture of schedule 5 controlled substance [MCL 333.74012(E)], manufacture official or counterfeit prescription form [MCL 333.74012(F)], possession of methamphetamine [MCL 333.74032B(1)], possession of certain schedule 1, 2, 3, or 4 controlled substances or controlled substance analogue [MCL 333.74032(B)-(A)], manufacture imitation controlled substance [MCL 333.74022(E), 333.74012(B)(1)], obtaining controlled substance by fraud, MCL 333.74071(C)], possession of counterfeit prescription form, [MCL 333.74071(G)], Uttering and Publishing (MCL 750.249), Obtaining Money Under False Pretenses (MCL 750.218), Larceny (MCL 750.365) and Retail Fraud cases [MCL 750.356 (C)].

This Docket Directive does not affect case packaging rules stated in the Court's Criminal Division Case Assignment Local Administrative Order.

The Wayne County Clerk, Circuit Court Case Processing Department, Adult Drug Court Unit and Circuit Court Information Technology Systems Bureau are directed to take appropriate action to accomplish the assignment of these cases.
