Criminal Division

The Criminal Division trial docket of Judge Carole F. Youngblood, excluding Felony Non-Support cases, shall be randomly reassigned as follows:

All pending cases shall be randomly reassigned to the trial judges.

All post-conviction cases shall be randomly reassigned to the Criminal Division Bench.

The Felony Non-Support cases shall be reassigned as follows:

Pending cases including those awaiting sentencing and pre-adjudication warrant status shall be assigned to the docket of Judge James A. Callahan.

Post-conviction cases shall be assigned to the docket of Judge Wade H. McCree.

The Wayne County Clerk, the Third Circuit Court Case Processing Department, and the Third Circuit Court Information Technology Systems Bureau are directed to take the steps necessary to accomplish this Directive.
