STATE OF MICHIGAN THIRD JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

SUBJECT: WAIVER OF FEES FOR FILING ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY TRANSCRIPTS

Pursuant to this Court's powers to administer the e-filing project authorized by Michigan Supreme Court Administrative Order (AO) 2011-1, in appeals from decisions of governmental agencies (case codes AA, AE, AP, and AL), in lieu of exempting from e-filing/e-service requirements the e-filing/e-service of Form 502 and the official transcript of the agency proceedings by a person or entity on behalf of the governmental agency, and to further the just, speedy and economical determination of appeals from governmental agencies involved in the e-filing pilot program;

IT IS ORDERED:

EFFECTIVE: August 22, 2014

- 1. MC Form 502 and official transcripts associated with appeals from governmental agency decisions (case codes AA, AE, AP, and AL), shall continue to be subject to the e-filing requirements of AO 2011-1.
- 2. In appeals from governmental agency decisions, a person or entity e-filing/e-serving the MC Form 502 and the official agency transcript on behalf of the governmental agency shall not be subject to the payment of e-filing/e-service fees.
- 3. The Wayne County Clerk acting as the Clerk of the Court shall not require the payment of e-filing/e-service fees, and shall not condition the acceptance of the form MC 502 or the official transcript of the agency proceedings where the form MC 502 or the official transcript are e-filed/e-served by a person or entity on behalf of the governmental agency.

The Wayne County Clerk, the Third Circuit Court case Processing Department, and the Third Circuit Court Information Technology Systems Bureau are directed to take the steps necessary to accomplish this Directive.
