SUBJECT: SETTING DELINQUENCY PRETRIAL HEARINGS FOR OUT-OF-CUSTODY PETITIONS

This Docket Directive is issued pursuant to MCR 8.110(C)(3)(a) and (h) and is necessary to ensure the efficient and timely scheduling of delinquency pretrial hearings within the Family Division – Juvenile Section.


IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Effective: January 4, 2021

FAMILY DIVISION – JUVENILE SECTION

All original out-of-custody delinquency petitions (youth that are not detained by a detention facility) that have been authorized by the Court shall be set for a pretrial hearing no sooner than 21 days and no later than 35 days after authorization on the docket of the assigned Judge or Referee.

The Wayne County Clerk, the Third Circuit Court Case Processing Department, and the Third Circuit Court Information Technology Systems Bureau are directed to take the steps necessary to accomplish this Directive.
