SELECTION OF MEDIATORS

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 1988-1

IT IS ORDERED;

Pursuant to MCR 2.403(D)(2) and (3), the following procedure for selecting mediation panels is established.

1. Mediation Clerk Designation.

The court designates the Mediation Supervisor to serve as the mediation clerk.

2. Mediation Selection Process.

The Board of Directors of the Mediation Tribunal Association shall establish the mediator pools, and shall also determine the qualifications of mediators, the composition of mediator pools, and the selection process for mediation panels.

3. Term of Mediators.

The term of a member of a mediation panel is two (2) days unless otherwise ordered by the Board of Directors.

4. Payment of Late Fee.

Failure to submit mediation materials to the Mediation Clerk within the time designated in M.C.R. 2.403(I)(2) subjects an offending party to a \$60 penalty to be paid at the time of the Mediation Hearing to the Mediation Tribunal Association.

5. This Administrative Order supersedes and repeals A.O. 1985-9.
