ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2001-04J PROBATE ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2001-03J

SECURITY POLICY FOR COURT FACILITIES

This administrative order is issued in accordance with Michigan Supreme Court Administrative Order 2001-1. The purpose of this order is to address the presence of weapons in court facilities.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. No weapons are allowed in any of the court facilities listed above. This prohibition does not apply to law enforcement officers who are transporting prisoners or attending to official business. The Chief Judges may authorize additional exceptions in extraordinary circumstances.
- 2. All persons and their belongings (unless specifically excepted) and all parcels are subject to screening by Sheriff's Deputies or Security personnel for the purpose of keeping weapons from entering any of these facilities.

If at any time there is an articulable and reasonable suspicion that a weapon may be found, a person or object is subject to search. The search shall be no more intrusive than necessary to protect against the dangers presented.

3. Notice shall be posted that "No weapons are permitted in this facility". All persons and parcels are subject to a search for weapons and restricted items as a condition of entry. Persons in violation of this order may be held in contempt of court.
