2. Wanda R. Cal:

- a. Will serve at the pleasure of the Chief Judge of the 3rd Circuit Court.
- b. Has taken the constitutional oath of office.
- c. Is a member, in good standing, of the State Bar of Michigan, pursuant to MCR 3.215.
- 3. **Referee Wanda R. Cal** is authorized to perform the following duties pursuant to MCR 3.913 and MCL 712A.10:
 - a. Conduct a preliminary inquiry or preside at hearings under the Juvenile Code, MCL 712A.1, et seq., and make recommended findings and conclusions except for those hearings specified in MCR 3.912(A), which include the following:
 - 1. A jury trial;
 - 2. A waiver proceeding under MCR 3.950;
 - The preliminary examination, trial and sentencing in a designated case;
 - 4. A proceeding on the issuance, modification or termination of a minor personal protection order.
 - b. In Child Protection Proceedings, may issue an ex parte placement order under MCR 3.963(B).
 - c. In conducting hearings, a Referee shall do all of the following:
 - 1. Administer oaths and examine witnesses;
 - 2. If a case requires a hearing and the taking of testimony, make a written signed report to the judge containing a summary of the testimony taken and a recommendation for the Court's findings and disposition.
