for a hearing pursuant to MCR 2.112(O)(3) to determine if this matter meets the statutory

requirements of MCL 600.8031, *et seq.*

Should Judge Oxholm determine that this matter meets the MCL 600.8031 *et seq* requirements of a business or commercial dispute, an order will be entered reassigning this case by blind draw to a Business Court Judge. MCR 2.112(O)(3). Should Judge Oxholm determine that this matter is a business or commercial dispute per MCL 600.8031 *et seq* which was improperly filed contrary to Michigan Court Rule and Local Administrative Order, Judge Oxholm may assess a sanction up to \$100 under MCR 2.114(E).

If Judge Oxholm determines that this matter does **not** meet the MCL 600.8031 *et seq* requirements of a business or commercial dispute, the matter will remain with the judge originally assigned to this matter.

The parties may appeal Judge Oxholm's decision regarding business court eligibility to Chief Judge Robert J. Colombo. MCR 2.112(O)(4). Chief Judge Colombo's ruling is a final decision and may not be appealed. MCR 2.112(O)(4).
